The Year in Review...

To the citizens and Honorable Board of Commissioners of Brown County, Ohio:

I am pleased to present the Brown County Engineers 2007 Annual Report for your review.

During 2007, the Brown County Engineer's Office administered construction and maintenance projects totaling over \$2.2 million.

Five bridges were replaced in 2007, totaling \$603,292.00. They were on Stringtown Road in Huntington Township, Mcffords Run Road in Huntington Township, Bardwell West Road in Sterling Township, Bodman Road in Sterling Township and Hartman Road in Union Township. The County received \$273,561 from the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) for the Meffords Run Road Bridge. The project was advertized for bids and Cooper Excavating, LLC was awarded the contract. The project was completed in early 2007. The other projects were completed using county forces.

The Brown County Engineer's Office works closely with all of the Township Trustees throughout the county to replace the deficient culverts on all of the township roads as well as the culverts on our county roads. Our crews replaced 61 culverts in 2007 for a total of \$159,909.

Seven roads, approximately 17.2 miles, were resurfaced with asphalt concrete holmix and bermed. The resurfacing was advertized for bid and the contract was awarded to Brown County Asphalt. The total cost for the resurfacing was \$788.868.80. The berming was completed using county forces at a cost of \$52,148.75.

Eighteen roads totaling 50.2 miles were sealed using county forces at a cost of \$345,435,44.

Other projects included the widening of Liming Van Thompson Road in Clark and Pike Townships for a total cost of \$68,304.92. All of the 17.2 miles of hotmix and most of the 50.2 miles of sealed roads were linestriped for a total cost of \$61,236.78. A roadside repair project was completed on White Oak Valley Road at a cost of \$14,524.74. Herbicidal Spraying was completed on the guardrail on all of our county roads at a cost of \$11,097.13.

Also, the Engineer's Office purchased some new equipment in 2007. Two tandem International dump trucks were purchased on state bid totaling \$204,626, a shop truck, for distributor and a fork lift were some of the other items. All totaled we spent \$410,910.50 on new equipment in 2007.

Looking Forward.....

A quality based consultant selection process was performed in 2007 for the design of the bridge replacement project on White Oak Valley Road as well as the bridge replacement project on Skiffsville Road. We were already under contract with a design firm for the Tri-County Highway bridge replacement project prior to 2007 and we look forward to nearing a construction date for all three of these projects in 2008.

Looking forward, the Engineer's Office has high expectations for this year. We plan to replace eight bridges in 2008. Six of the bridges will be replaced by county forces while the other two will be advertized for bids, one of which will be partly funded by OPWC. We plan to resurface approximately 24.9 miles of roads with asphalt concrete hotmix. We also plan to widen approximately 12.2 miles of roads.


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Serving Brown County Since 1817
