Orab Pike, Georgetown, Ohio, 45121, the Brown County Solid Waste Authority, (hereinafter referred to as "the BCSWA"), 800 Mt. Orab Pike, Georgetown, Ohio 45121 and Todd Cluxton, the Brown County Engineer (herein after referred to as "The Engineer"), 25 Veterans Blvd. Georgetown, Ohio 45121.

WHEREAS, the BCSWA's goal is to reduce reliance on landfills and promote recycling and the use of recycled content products, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners, the BCSWA and the Engineer wish to promote the use of recycled asphalt products while assisting the Brown County townships and villages with road construction and repair projects, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners endorse this project and will coordinate the funding mechanisms thereof, and

WHEREAS, the BCSWA has budgeted \$60,000.00 of funding for such recycled asphalt products during CY2012 for such projects, and

WHEREAS, the Engineer is willing to implement and provide management for such projects, and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual agreements hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. The BCSWA will provide \$60,000.00 for the purpose of promoting asphalt recycling which shall be paid to the Brown County Engineer by September 13th, 2012, that amount of funding to be paid from the P34 Solid Waste account. The Brown County Engineer will then use those funds to assist Brown County township and villages with road construction and repair projects using recycled asphalt product in amounts that will be divided among all townships and villages in a fair and equitable manner to be determined by the Brown County Engineer that will result in a approximate combined total of \$40,000.00 going to township projects and \$20,000.00 going to village projects.
- 2. Any party hereto can terminate this agreement by providing 30 days written notice to the other parties. Upon termination, any unused funds shall be returned to the BCSWA.
