Dear Ms. Cole:

This is in response to your correspondence received August 31, 2021, regarding the proposed rehabilitation work for the property located at 2 Main Street using CDBG funds from the Ohio Department of Development. The comments of the Ohio State Historic Preservation Office are made pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended, and the associated regulations at 36 CFR Part 800.

The proposed rehabilitation work for 2 Main Street includes adding new window openings to the 1<sup>st</sup> story of the south façade of the building. Since the property at 2 Main Street is a contributing resource in the National Register-listed Ripley Historic District (NR Ref# 85000552), the project work must meet the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation in order to avoid adverse effects.

After receiving the updated renderings on August 31, I met with my colleagues and we came to a consensus. It is the opinion of the SHPO that the planned work, if completed as proposed and meets the following **condition**, will meet the Standards, thereby having **no adverse effect** on historic properties. The conditions are as follows:

- While the new windows must be compatible with the historic appearance and character of the building, the window openings will differentiate from the old historic window openings. The new window openings will be plain, without trim or period architectural details so they can be identified as contemporary openings.

No further coordination with this office is necessary unless there is a change in the project;

The asbestos program regulates two primary areas:

### EMISSIONS CONTROL

The Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-20 contains regulations for controlling asbestos emissions from demolition and renovation projects. Ohio's regulations are consistent with U.S. EPA's National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) regarding asbestos. The regulations require that contractors do several things, such as provide a notification, conduct thorough inspections to determine the presence of asbestos, follow specific work practices, and ensure proper disposal of asbestos-containing material.

### LICENSE, CERTIFICATION AND COURSE MANAGEMENT

The asbestos program licenses and certifies companies and persons directly involved with the asbestos abatement industry. OAC 3745-22 contains regulations pertaining to contractors performing asbestos removal projects, project supervisors, project designers, workers removing asbestos, persons inspecting buildings for asbestos-containing materials and developing plans to manage asbestos found in a facility, persons conducting air sampling for asbestos and the companies that provide required asbestos training. 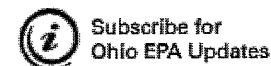
