PUBLIC HEARING

Community Housing Impact and Preservation-Lead Abatement Program

A public hearing will be held on September 26th, 2022 at 10:00 A.M., in the Brown County Commissioners Office at 800 Mt Orab Pike, Georgetown, Ohio 45121. The purpose of the hearing is to inform the citizens of Brown County that the county intends to apply to the Ohio Department of Development for funding provided by the Ohio Department of Health and administered by the Ohio Department of Development, Office of Community Development. The county is eligible for FY 2022 funding under the Community Housing Impact & Preservation-Lead Abatement Program (CHIP-LAP), providing it meets program requirements. On March 2nd, 2022 at 1:00 P.M. the county conducted its first public hearing to inform citizens about the CDBG and HOME programs, how it may be used, what activities are eligible, and other important program requirements. The CHIP-LAP program is a pilot program related to the CHIP program so not originally covered in Public Hearing #1. The county is proposing to undertake the following CHIP-LAP activities for PY 22, all of which meet national objective of benefit to low/moderate income persons:
