ABOLISHMENT OF THE CUSTODIAL/JANITORIAL PROGRAM

O.R.C. 124.321(D)(1)

The Board of County Commissioners of Brown County, Ohio, met on the 20th day of November, 2013, in regular session at the offices of said Board in the Administration Building, Georgetown, Ohio, with the following members present:

Tony Applegate, President Darryl Gray, Member Barry Woodruff, Member

The following resolution was presented by Mr. Gray, who moved its adoption, and seconded by Mr. Woodruff.

WHEREAS, the Board has been advised by the Brown County Budget Commission that revenues for fiscal year 2014 are expected to be insufficient to meet current demands and that operating expenses are expected to sharply increase, especially in the area of health care and payments on debt obligations. A copy of said letter is attached hereto and fully incorporated herein.

WHEREAS, the Board finds the projected shortfall to anticipated revenues for fiscal year 2014 to be approximately \$679,000.00, and further finds and confirms that the county has a projected deficiency in funding and cannot maintain current levels of staffing and operations for fiscal year 2014.

WHEREAS, the Board has previously dissolved the Bureau of Travel and Tourism for reasons of economic economy; and laid off its sole employee.

WHEREAS, the Board has implemented cost reduction studies, including research into the economic impact of abolishing the cleaning and janitorial program, which is a subdepartment within the maintenance department.

WHEREAS, as part of the above mentioned research, the Board obtained, through public bidding, cost estimates for outsourcing the cleaning and janitorial requirements to an (Continued on next page)

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independent contractor;

WHEREAS, the bid results indicated that hiring an independent cleaning/janitorial contractor to perform essentially the same services as the in-house cleaning and janitorial program would cost the county \$20,889.60 annually.

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the cost of the salaries and benefits of the in-house cleaning and janitorial services cost the county \$71,232.94 annually.

WHEREAS, the Board finds the county would save \$50,343.34 annually if the county abolished the in-house cleaning and janitorial program and contracted with an independent cleaning/janitorial contractor.

WHEREAS, the Board finds it in the best interest of the county to abolish the in-house cleaning and janitorial services program and hire an independent contractor to perform essentially the same services;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: Pursuant to R.C. 124.321(D), the Board hereby abolishes the cleaning and janitorial program, effective 11:59 p.m., December 31, 2013;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: The employees in the affected classifications shall be laid off in compliance with the procedures in R.C. 124.321, et. seq., and the Ohio Administrative Code, with a final work date no later than December 31, 2013.
