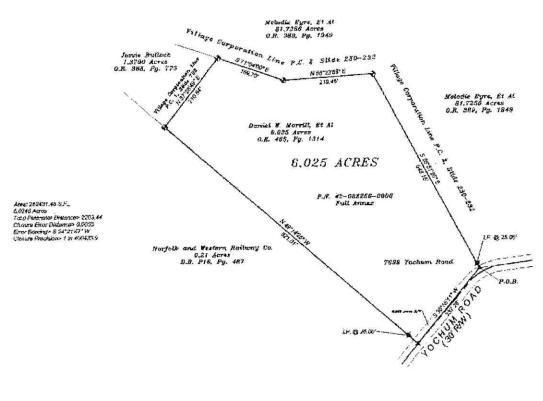

- Nothing contained in this Annexation Agreement shall be construed to provide for the payment of service fees to the TOWNSHIP by the VILLAGE.
- 9. There shall be no reallocation of minimum mandated levies established pursuant to section 5705.31 of the Revised Code between the VILLAGE and the TOWNSHIP in connection with this appexation.
- 10. Nothing contained in this Annexation Agreement shall be construed to require the issuance of notes and bonds or other debt obligations by the VILLAGE or the TOWNSHIP for public purposes.

The VILLAGE will provide the following services to the Territory following annexation thereof; police protection, fire protection and such public utilities as may be available, provided the VILLAGE is able to furnish such utilities without over-burdening the existing infrastructure of the VILLAGE and provided such territory is sufficiently developed to make delivery of such services economically feasible, all pursuant to and in accordance with the ordinances and resolutions of the VILLAGE.
