AGREEMENT

Witness this agreement by and between Ripley Union Rural Water Association, hereinafter referred to as "RURWA" and the Brown County Board of Commissioners hereinafter referred to as "BCC".

Whereas the Ripley Union Rural Water Association, is the governing body for all water infrastructure for the village of Ripley and certain areas around the village of Ripley, and is the owner of a certain water tower located adjacent to 5260 Martin Lane, Ripley Ohio 45167.

Whereas the Brown County Board of Commissioners duly elected for Brown County, Ohio, are in need of facilities to be used for emergency radio communications to be utilized by the Brown County Communication Center.

Whereas the Ripley Union Rural Water Association, has previously agreed to make the water tank site mentioned above available to the Brown County Communication Center for the improvement in emergency radio communications,

- 1. The RURWA shall grant the BCC rights to use the water tank and site to install the public safety radio equipment is deemed necessary to serve the public safety users located in Brown County. This may include but not be limited to installation of appropriate electrical services, the building of a radio shelter, security fencing, and installation of various radio antennas and grid microwave dish on the water tank. No further improvements other than those discussed October 7, 2010 or that are already on site will be performed without the express consent of the RURWA.
- 2. The BCC agree to save the RURWA harmless for any and all liability to the installed equipment resulting from their use of the property.
- 3. The BCC will designate the Director of the Communication Center to work with the RURWA as to the location of the antennas & grid dish on the tank, antenna mounting used on the tank, placement of transmission lines, building size and placement as well as generator and propane tank placement.
 - 4. This agreement shall be for an initial period of 120 months, (10 years) and renewable for 120 months, (10 years) thereafter unless terminated by either party in writing and providing at least 180 days, (6 month) advance notice after expiration of the first 10 year contract period. Improvements made by BCC cannot be requested to be removed from the site during the first 10 year contract period.
 - 5. The BCC shall pay to the RWD the sum of \$1.00 per year for the lease of the property.
