Whereas, Brown County, Ohio has been or is immediately threatened by a natural/man-made/technological hazard and/or nuclear or conventional attack, and;

Damages impacting the citizens and political subdivisions of the county on Wednesday, July 6, 2022 as a result of weather events The National Weather Service confirmed an EF1 Tornado in Lake Lorelei and the surrounding areas of Perry Township. The damages range from minor to moderate damage to 30% of the residences in the Lake Lorelei Community to 5 uninhabitable homes of full-time residents, significant damage to public utilities, and varying degrees of damage to trees resulting in unpassable roadways and other life safety issues;

Now, therefore, we, the Brown County Board of Commissioners, declare that a state of emergency exists in the county and that we hereby invoke and declare those portions of the Ohio Revised Code which are applicable to the conditions and have caused the issuance of this proclamation, to be in full force and effect in the county for the exercise of all necessary emergency authority for protection of the lives and property of the people of Brown County and the restoration of local government with a minimum of interruption.

Reference is hereby made to all appropriate laws, statutes, ordinances and resolutions, and particularly to Section 5502 of the Ohio Revised Code.

All public offices and employees of Brown County are hereby directed to exercise the utmost diligence in the discharge of duties required of them for the duration of the emergency and in execution of emergency laws, regulations, and directives-state and local.

All citizens are called upon and directed to comply with necessary emergency measures, to cooperate with public officials and disaster services forces in executing emergency operation plans, and to obey and comply with the lawful directions of properly identified officers.
