This Agreement is entered into this 30th day of December, 2010, by and between the Board of Commissioners of Brown County, Ohio, (hereinafter referred to as "Commissioners"), 800 Mt. Orab Pike, Georgetown, OH, 45121, and the Brown County Solid Waste Authority, (hereinafter referred to as "BCSWA"), 800 Mt. Orab Pike, Georgetown, OH, 45121.

In consideration of the promises herein below delineated parties do hereby agree as follows:

- 1. BCSWA retains Commissioners to provide bookkeeping and office administration services as described in Exhibit A, attached hereto an fully incorporated herein, beginning on January 1, 2011, and ending on December 31, 2011.
- 2. The Commissioners represents that it has sufficient training, expertise, staffing, and experience to professionally provide those services as delineated in Exhibit A.
- 3. BCSWA shall pay the Commissioners a total sum of Thirty Thousand (\$30,000.00), with one payment to be made by January 25th, of the contract year, January 1_{st}, 2011 till December 31_{st}, 2011.
