RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE COUNTY OF BROWN RECOVERY ZONE FOR PURPOSES OF SECTIONS 1400U-1, 1400U-2 AND 1400U-3 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986, AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, Section 1400u-1 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code) authorizes the County of Brown, Ohio (the "County") to designate a "recovery zone" for purposes of issuing (a) Recovery Zone Economic Development Bonds under Section 1400U-2 of the Code and (b) Recovery Zone Facility Bonds under Section 1400U-3 of the Code and

WHEREAS, the term "recovery zone" means (a) any area designated by the County as having significant poverty, unemployment, rate of home foreclosures or general distress, (b) any area designated by the County as economically distressed by reason of the closure or realignment of a military installation pursuant to the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Act of 1990, and (c) any area for which a designation as an empowerment zone or a renewal community is in effect and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Bureau of Jobs and Family Services reports that unemployment in the County rose from 7.9% in November, 2008 to 11.5% in November, 2009;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF BROWN, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the entire County is designated as a "recovery zone" for purposes of Section 1400U-1, 1400U-2 and 1400U-3 of the Code based on the finding of this Board of County Commissioners that County-wide unemployment rates have increased significantly from November 2008 to November 2009.

SECTION 2. That the Board of County Commissioners of the County hereby finds that the County, as a "recovery zone" meets the requirements of Section 1400U-1 of the Code, in that the County is an area having significant poverty, unemployment, rate of home foreclosures and general distress.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Board of County Commissioners concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board of County Commissioners and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
