- c. Provide new applicants a list of Consulting Foresters that are available to write Forestry Management Plans for (of) the Forestry CAUV program; when requested by the landowner.
- d. Work with the landowners to stay in compliance of the CAUV specifications.
- e. The service mentioned is not to exceed 25% of the total workload of the Brown SWCD (District) Staff.

3. It is mutually agreed:

- a. That this Contract is in effect for a period of one year, beginning June 1, 2014 through May 31, 2015, but may be amended or terminated at any time by either party giving ten (10) days notice in writing to the other.
- b. That this Contract may only be amended by a written amendment, signed by both parties hereto.
- c. That this Contract shall be interpreted according to the laws of the State of Ohio.
