WHEREAS, the Brown County Board of Commissioners has previously contracted with

CME Pipe Lining to make repairs to the Brown County Government Services Building sewer

line;

WHEREAS, during performance of said contract, the manager of CME Pipe Lining has discovered a lateral pipe run in need of emergency repairs, which requires the digging of pits inside the building;

WHEREAS, CME Pipe Lining has proposed to the Board a work description and estimate for the emergency repairs;

WHEREAS, the Board finds a real and present emergency exists in that the sewer line is in need of emergency repair to continue the essential operation of offices housed within the Government Services Building and preserve the health and safety of the employees and the public;

WHEREAS, the Board funds, pursuant to O.R.C. 307.86 (A)(1), the cost of the emergency repair is less than \$125,000.00, however, the Board also finds there are no other contractors to solicit estimates from that have the capability to make the emergency repairs in the manner and time frame as the current contractor, CME Pipe Lining;

WHEREAS, the Board also finds, pursuant to O.R.C. 307.86 (A)(2), there is an actual, physical disaster to the sewer structure;

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Brown County, Ohio, that on the above findings, hereby authorizes, approves, and consents to enter an Agreement for the scope of work in the Proposal for the sewer repair services, in the amount of \$16,750.00, without bidding, to have the sewer line repaired immediately, a copy of the proposed Change Order is attached hereto and fully incorporated herein; Upon call of the roll:
